

Mr Lee Kuan Yew and Singapore's founding leaders exemplified key values such as boldness and resilience, integrity, multiculturalism and service to others before self. They turned their vision for Singapore into reality.

## Their values and ideals remain relevant for Singapore's present and future.

To commemorate the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Mr Lee's birth in 2023, the Lee Kuan Yew Centennial Fund has been established for donations from the private and people sectors. The Fund supports the development of Singapore youth to become visionary leaders with the imagination and determination to shape Singapore's future as an exceptional nation.

It will be used to support three education-related initiatives to develop and recognise young leaders in Singapore. The initiatives are: (i) Singapore Young Leaders Programme (managed by the Ministry of Education); (ii) Expansion of Lee Kuan Yew Scholarship Awards (managed by Lee Kuan Yew Scholarship Fund (Company Limited by Guarantee) Board of Directors); and (iii) Lee Kuan Yew Post-Graduate Scholarship for Urban Greenery and Ecology (managed by the National Parks Board). The Fund may also be used for other education-related initiatives in future.

Through these initiatives, we seek to inspire the younger generation of Singaporeans to shape a better, brighter future for our nation.

To encourage donations to the Lee Kuan Yew Centennial Fund, the Government will provide one-off dollar-for-dollar matching, capped at a total of \$\$50 million.

The Lee Kuan Yew Centennial Fund will be managed as a specific fund under the Ministry of Education's Education Fund where the donations received, and income generated, can be used to fund the initiatives. The Education Fund Board of Trustees will administer the donations and make decisions on the investment and disbursement on the Fund, including utilisation of donations for other education-related initiatives beyond the initiatives specified in this information sheet.
